

**MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL CALLED MEETING
TO CANVASS THE ELECTION RESULTS
OF THE RECENT SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION
OF THE CITY OF HARTSELLE, ALABAMA
NOVEMBER 15, 2016**

The City Council of the City of Hartselle, Alabama, met in a Special Called Canvass Meeting at noon on Tuesday, November 15, 2016 to canvass the results of the recent Special Municipal Election inside the Council Chambers at the Hartselle Municipal Building. Council President Pro-Tempore Tankersley called the meeting to order.

Mayor Randy Garrison led the invocation.

The following were present for the meeting: Council President Pro-Tempore Dwight Tankersley, Council Members Chuck Gill and Virginia Alexander, Mayor Randy Garrison, and City Clerk-Controller Rita S. Lee, who also acted as secretary of the meeting. Council President Kenny Thompson, Council Member Matt Broom and City Attorney Larry Madison were absent. Having a quorum present, Council President Pro-Tempore Tankersley declared the proceedings open for business.

City Clerk-Controller, Rita S. Lee, read the results from the Board of Registrars concerning the eighteen Provisional Ballots that were cast in the election. Ms. Lee then proceeded to open the envelopes, tallied the votes and announced the results to the Council.

Council President Pro-Tempore Tankersley then asked the Council to adopt Resolution 16-1115 to officially canvass the election results. Council Member Alexander motioned to approve Resolution 16-1115; Council Member Gill seconded the motion. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

At this time, Council President Pro-Tempore Tankersley asked for comments from the Mayor, Council Members or City Attorney. None were made.

Council President Pro-Tempore Tankersley then asked for comments from the audience. None were made.

With no other business to come before the Council, Council Member Gill motioned to adjourn; Council Member Alexander seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously by voice vote and the meeting was adjourned at 12:15 p.m.
